Education Committee's Policy and Guidance for Examiners and others involved in University Examinations (http://www.admin.ox.ac.uk/edc/qa/policies/) states that

"Divisions and other supervisory bodies must ensure that they have appropriate mechanisms in place to ... make all reports (other than those where individuals might be identifiable) available to students via appropriate mechanisms."

Divisional policy

The MPLS Division continues to require departments and standing joint committees to follow the earlier, more specific, EPSC guidance:

- that the reports of both internal and external examiners are made available
 - o online within the ox.ac.uk domain,
 - in a suitably anonymised form where necessary.
 - where a minimum of six candidates has been entered for the examination in question,
 - after the reports have been considered by the appropriate committee in the department or faculty;
- that the eligible student populations all students on or who might be expected to progress to the programme(s) of study which the reports cover – should have access to those reports (e.g. through single-sign-on or other password-protected means), and that the form of access adopted should be checked by the department publishing the reports to ensure that the eligible students are indeed able to access the reports.
